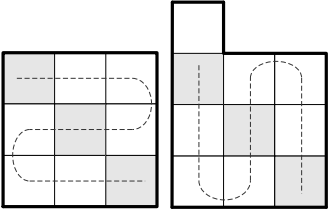
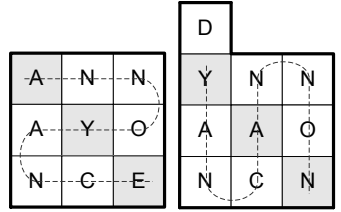
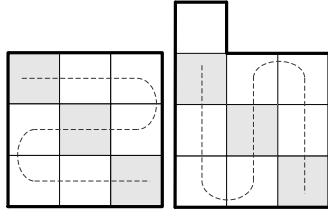


Ninefold Path (and then some) by Story

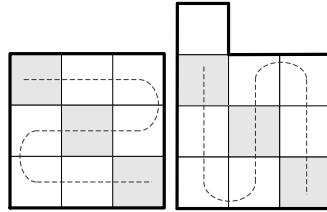
The answer to the clue under each pair of grids should be written into the left-side grid, weaving back and forth as shown by the path. A second word can be entered in the right-side grid, beginning from the protruding square, and following the up-and-down path. The letters in both words are the same, except for the additional starting letter, and the letters in the gray spaces, which you must change. The second word will be the answer to one of the clues at the bottom of the page. An example is shown at right, where ANNOYANCE becomes the actress DYAN CANNON.



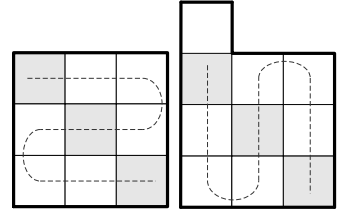
